KELVIN SCALE		CORRECT LIGHTING CONDITIONS FOR COLOR APPROVAL:				
HIGH TEMPERATURE (COOLER TINT: BLUE/GREEN)		Using the right lighting condition is VERY IMPORTANT for evaluating your Custom Color samples. The Kelvin Scale chart, at the left, shows how colors will change dramatically under various lighting conditions. The higher the Kelvin number, the cooler the color will look. The lower the number the warmer the color will look. When a color sample is viewed under a fluorescent light in an office or outside in direct sunlight the color may have a blue or green tint. If viewed indoors under an incandescent light, the color may appear more red. The ideal light source for checking a sample is incandescent lights (around 2700 kelvin) because most homes use this light source. Using your office's fluorescent lights or direct sunlight may give you inaccurate results.

Custom Color Program

PROGRAM DETAILS & REQUIREMENTS

Minimums *There is a 30 piece minimum per color/profile.* If you can't meet the 30 piece minimum, we started a new program in 2015 called "**Coordinating Moldings Program (CMP)**". Contact your sales representative for more details.

Overage/Shortage With all custom match orders there is a possible overage/shortage of 10% per color/profile. Your company will be expected to accept these overages/shortages at regular custom match cost if this happens.

Color Match Lead Time There is a four to six week lead time for the custom color process from the date your samples are received to ship out your sample for approval.
If you send in over 10 planks, it could take six to eight weeks for your custom color samples to ship for approval.

Approval You will need to indicate the Color ID Number exactly as it appears on your approval stick.



Production Lead Time There will be a three week lead time from the date the initial custom color order is placed until the date it ships from our facility. All orders placed after the initial order will be a 5-10 business day lead time from the day the order is placed until the date it ships from our factory.

Non-Returnable *This is a custom product and will be non-returnable.*

Consideration It is time consuming and costly for us to create custom colors for your floors. Please take this into consideration by only sending us planks to match that you are serious about ordering.

Preferred Plank

To get your custom color started, just send us a box of planks of the particular floor you would like coordinating moldings for. If you can only send us one plank, please remember what you give us, is what you get out. To help you determine the best plank to send, please follow the guidelines below. **Obviously not all flooring can be perfect. Wood being a natural product will often have some imperfections. With this in mind, please send us the best plank possible.**
